**General Information**

**QUALIFICATIONS**

The Mayor and each Councilmembers shall meet and maintain the following qualifications to be eligible for office:

- (a) Be a United States Citizen
- (b) Have been a continuous resident of Texas for at least 12 months as of the deadline for filing for the office.
- (c) Have resided in the city for at least six months preceding election day
- (d) Be a registered voter
- (e) Be 18 years of age or older upon the commencement of the term to be filed at the election
- (f) Not have been convicted of a felony for which he or she has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
- (g) Not have been deemed mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court.
- (h) Not be indebted to the City

**TERMS OF OFFICE**

Mayor shall serve a two (2) year term

Councilmembers shall serve a two (2) year term

**CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS**

The Mayor and the City Council shall meet on a regular monthly basis (regular meeting). Council meetings are scheduled for the third Wednesday of each month, 7:00pm.
