

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 14, 1999, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS, THE ADOPTION OR REJECTION OF A PROPOSAL TO ADD ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 4B OF THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT, V.T.C.S. 5190.6.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

Section 1.

WHEREAS, an election was held on August 14, 1999, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of Wallis, Texas, the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

THE ADOPTION OF AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX TO BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 4B, ARTICLE 5190.6, V.T.C.S., AS AMENDED (THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT OF 1979), INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PROJECTS FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW OR EXPANDED ENTERPRISES, INCLUDING A PROJECT TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES, STREETS AND ROADS, DRAINAGE AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS, DEMOLITION OF EXISTING STRUCTURES, GENERAL MUNICIPALLY OWNED IMPROVEMENTS, AS WELL AS ANY IMPROVEMENTS OR FACILITIES THAT ARE RELATED TO ANY OF THOSE PROJECTS AND ANY OTHER PROJECT THAT PROMOTES OR DEVELOPS NEW OR EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES, AS WELL AS PROJECTS REQUIRED OR SUITABLE FOR USE FOR PROFESSIONAL AND AMATEUR SPORTS, ATHLETIC, ENTERTAINMENT, AMPHITHEATERS, CONCERT HALLS, TOURIST, CONVENTION AND PUBLIC PARK PURPOSES AND EVENTS, INCLUDING STADIUMS, BALL PARKS AUDITORIUMS, LEARNING CENTERS, PARKS AND PARK FACILITIES, OPEN SPACE IMPROVEMENTS, MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS, MUSEUMS, EXHIBITION FACILITIES, AND RELATED STORE, RESTAURANT, CONCESSION, AND AUTOMOBILE PARKING FACILITIES, RELATED AREA TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES, AND RELATED ROADS, STREETS AND WATER AND SEWER FACILITIES AND OTHER RELATED ITEMS THAT ENHANCE ANY OF THOSE ITEMS.

and, **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Wallis, Texas, having examined the returns of said election and all election procedures heretofore occurring, finds that said election was duly and properly ordered, and that due notice of said election was given, and that said election was in all respects regularly and lawfully held, and that said returns thereof have been duly and legally made, and that the following votes were cast "FOR" and "AGAINST" the proposition:

FOR	<u>79</u>
AGAINST	<u>7</u>

It is therefore found that the Proposition to add one-half of one percent sales and use tax within the City under the provisions of Section 4B of the Development Corporation Act V.T.C.S., 5190.6 was approved and passed by a majority of 72 votes.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND DECLARED that at said election the above stated proposition was adopted.

The order was read, and upon motion made by Council Member Tim Raska, and seconded by Council Member Rodell Northington, was passed and approved by a majority vote at the meeting of the City of Wallis City Council on the 18th day of August, 1999.
