

AN ORDINANCE DISPENSING WITH THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL IN THE CITY OF WALLIS AND CONFERRING THE DUTIES OF SAID OFFICE UPON A PEACE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Article 999, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, authorizes the governing body of any city having less than five thousand (5,000) inhabitants according to the last preceding Federal Census by ordinance to dispense with the office of Marshal, and at the same time by such ordinance to confer the duties of said office upon some peace officer of the county, provided that no Marshal elected by the people shall be removed from office before the expiration of the term of office to which he was elected; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Wallis, Texas had less than five thousand (5,000) inhabitants according to the last preceding Federal Census; and,

WHEREAS, the office of Marshal in the City of Wallis is now vacant; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Wallis lies within and is situated in the County of Austin, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, Dow Easton, Deputy Sheriff

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Aldermen (CITY COUNCIL) (BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS)
OF THE CITY OF WALLIS:

Section 1. The office of Marshal in the City of Wallis, Texas is hereby dispensed with and abolished effective upon the passage of this ordinance.

Section 2. The duties of the office of Marshal of the City of Wallis are hereby conferred upon Dow Easton,
