

ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH AN ITEMIZED ESTIMATE OF THE EXPENSE OF CONDUCTING EACH DEPARTMENT AND OFFICE OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS, FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR AND APPROXIMATING MONEY FOR THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND PURPOSES OF SUCH ESTIMATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the appropriation for the ensuing fiscal year beginning the 1st day of July, 1979 and ending the 30th day of September, 1980, for the departments and purposes of the City of Wallis being fixed and determined in accordance with the attached Exhibit "A" (itemized budget of City expenditures).

Section 2. Each City department shall be provided with such revenue as may be secured and as set out in the attached Exhibit "A" and such money shall be used to meet the requirements of each department.

Section 3. The distribution and division of the said appropriations shall be made in accordance with the said budget of expenditures (Exhibit "A") as adopted by the City Council.

Section 4. That the City Council did provide for public hearings on the 17th day of July, 1979, prior to final passage of this ordinance with proper notice of said hearings in the official newspaper of the City of Wallis.

Section 5. That this ordinance was presented for final passage at least ten (10) days after publication of the notice of public hearing.

Section 6. Should any part of this ordinance be declared invalid or void by a proper Court, such judgment shall not affect the remaining sections of this ordinance which shall remain in full force or effect.

Section 7. That all ordinances heretofore made are hereby repeated if same are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and shall be in

full force and effect from and after the date of it's passage and publication, said date being September 18, 1979.
