THE CITY OF Wallis SOCIAL SECURITY FUND:

WHEREAS, under the provisions of (1) House Bill 603, Acts 52nd Leg., R. S. 1951, and (2) Public Law 734, 81st Congress, ch. 2d, H. R. 6000, incorporated cities of this State may enter into agreements with the State Department of Public Welfare and secure the benefits of Federal Old-Age and Survivors Insurance, as outlined in said laws; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of this (City Council) (Board of Commissioners) that the extension of this Old-Age and Survivors Insurance System will be of great benefit not only to the employees of the municipality but to the municipality by attracting to it and enabling it to retain the best of personnel and thus increase the efficiency of its government; and it is deemed that the payment by the municipality of its portion of the cost of said system is a payment for municipal purposes.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this (City Council) (Board of Commissioners) to authorize the making of any and all necessary agreements in order to secure the benefits of said acts; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE (CITY COUNCIL) (BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS) OF THE CITY OF Wallis

1. That the (City Council) (~~Board of Commissioners~~) acting for and on behalf of the City of Wallis..... shall enter into all necessary agreements with the State Department of Public Welfare for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the above-mentioned acts.

2. That Hon. Jerry F. Sliva....., Mayor, is hereby appointed as Agent of the (City Council) (Board of Commissioners) and of the City to execute all necessary agreements and instruments for and in behalf of said (City Council) (Board of Commissioners) and City.

3. That the (City Secretary) (S. A. Easton.....) is hereby directed to be the person responsible for making assessments, collections, payments, and reports, as required by the State Department of Public Welfare.

4. That a sufficient sum of money be allocated and set aside from available funds for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the above-mentioned acts, such money so allocated and set aside to be known as the City of..... Social Security Fund, which fund shall be set aside and maintained in the regular city depository.
