

Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Wallis will receive bids for Clay Pipe Replacement and manhole additions, complete in-place in the City of Wallis until 6 p.m on Wednesday, May 15, 2024 at the office of the City of Wallis, 6810 Guyler St., Wallis, TX 77485. The bids will be publicly opened during City Council meeting on May 15, 2024 in City Council Chambers of the City of Wallis, 6810 Guyler St., Wallis, TX 77485.

Bidders are invited to bid items and quantities of work in the contract as follows:

Contract 1 – Clay Pipe Replacement; Manhole Additions; and Service Reconnections.

Bid/Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are on file at Weishuhn Engineering, Inc and Wilson Engineering Co., PLLC.

A Non Mandantory Pre-bid Conference will be held on Wednesday, April 17, 2024 at 10:00 am at the office of the City of Wallis, 6810 Guyler St., Wallis, TX 77485.

Electronic copies of Bid Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are available on CIVCAST.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Wallis or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas General Land Office and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin. Adherence to the City's Section 3 Policy is required for contracts and subcontracts in excess of \$100,000.

The City of Wallis reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by City of Wallis for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award. All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.
